



## **Micromine Awarded for Industry Excellence**

The awards were held on the 22 October 2008 in Sydney and are an initiative of the mining technology magazine 'Australian Mining'.

Micromine was also ranked in the 'BRW Fast 100'. This publication ranks Australian companies with up to 200 staff according to their average annual turnover growth over three years.
